Performance Competition

Conditions of entry

1. The competition shall be run from 1 May until 30 April of the following year.
2. The entry fee is \$10 per pony or cob and payable on application for entry.

4. The completed Entry Forms and Score Cards to be returned to the above address, not later than 15 May.
5. Please use a separate entry form for each pony. You may have as many forms and entries as you wish but **ALL** entries must be on an official form.
6. All ponies/cobs must be registered in the Welsh Stud Book of N.Z. or in the Partbred Register. Registration Numbers and Breeding to be given on the Entry Form.
7. All classes and competitions to be under Saddle or in Harness. **Classes for Turnout or Best Rider/Driver DO NOT COUNT.** Points to be gained at all recognized A & P Shows, competitions affiliated to A & P Societies, Hunter Trials organized by any recognized Hunt Club, Equestrian Federation competitions, Open Pony Club/Driving Club events and gymkhanas, other Shows and Sports Days etc., **PROVIDED THEY ARE FOR OPEN COMPETITION.**
8. The competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over.
9. Any pony/cob sold during the competition year, may have the previous owners points, transferred to the new owner, on application.

The CLIFTON TROPHY, presented by Lady Diana Isaac and a BRONZE MEDAL donated by the Society will be awarded to the Registered Pony/Cob gaining the most points during the year. All sections of the Stud Book are eligible for these four placings.

The TY GWYN SOLATAIRE MEMORIAL TROPHY, presented by Diane Kimpton, replaces the COMMITTEE SHIELD, presented by Priscilla Neil and is awarded to the Most Versatile Registered Welsh entry. In the event of that being the Clifton Trophy winner, another entry is to be selected by the committee. All sections of the Stud Book are eligible.

The CHAWTON SPRITE SALVER, presented by Catherine Howell is awarded to the Registered Welsh Pony/Cob with the most points in Harness. All sections of the Stud Book are eligible.

The LIZ DEANS MEMORIAL TROPHY, presented by Lois Newick, is awarded to the most points in the Leading Rein/First Ridden Sections gained by a Registered Welsh. All sections of the Stud Book are eligible.

The LORIEN STALLION TROPHY, presented by Paul and Colleen Rebay, is awarded to the highest scoring Registered Stallion or if there are no Stallions entered, to the Stallion whose Registered off-spring gain the most points. All sections of the Stud Book are eligible.

There is a SPECIAL ROSETTE, awarded to the BREEDER of the winner of the Clifton Trophy.

There are 1st – 4th Rosettes awarded in all sections and SPECIAL ROSETTES awarded by the committee, to Registered ponies/cobs for outstanding achievements, so PLEASE, write down everything your pony/cob does during the year.
