Current Rules

MSS 2.1 Hunter Jumping

o) Jumping classes may be divided into sections identical to the flat classes.

Champion classes in this division may be offered as an additional class where all comers may start or may be offered as in all other divisions to winners only with the second placed jumper to the champion Judged alongside the remaining winners for reserve. Examples of additional classes that may be added to the schedule are; additional Novice classes, Wire Jump, Qualified Hunters, Handy Hunter

i. Ponies - not exceeding 148cm

Class xxx Novice Pony Hunter over fences, 0-5 wins

Class xxx Open Pony Hunter over fences, not exceeding 138cm

Class xxx Open Pony Hunter over fences, over 138cm and not exceeding 148cm

ii. Horses - over 148cm

Class xxx Novice Hunter over fences, 0-5 wins

Class xxx Open Hunter over fences, over 148cm and not exceeding 163cm

Class xxx Open Hunter over fences, over 163cm

Class xxx Lady's Hunter over fences – to be ridden by a lady

Class xxx Gentleman's Hunter over fences – to be ridden by a gentleman

MSS 2.1 Hunter Jumping

o) Additional classes that may be added to the schedule are; additional Novice classes, Wire Jump, Qualified Hunters, Handy Hunter, Lady's Hunter, Gentleman's Hunter

i. Ponies - not exceeding 148cm

- Class xxx Novice Pony Hunter over fences, 0-5 wins
- Class xxx Open Pony Hunter over fences, not exceeding 138cm
- Class xxx Open Pony Hunter over fences, over 138cm and not exceeding 148cm

Champion and Reserve Champion Hunter Jumping Pony to be judged from the winners of the open classes and any additional classes, except novice, noted above. Second placed Hunter Jumping Pony to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

ii. Horses - over 148cm

- Class xxx Novice Hunter over fences, 0-5 wins
- Class xxx Open Hunter over fences, over 148cm and not exceeding 163cm
- Class xxx Open Hunter over fences, over 163cm

Champion and Reserve Champion Hunter Jumping Horse to be judged from the winners of the open classes and any additional classes, except novice, noted above. Second placed Hunter Jumping Horse to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.
