CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **All entries** to be registered with The Welsh Pony and Cob Society of New Zealand (Inc.) in either the Purebred Stud Book or the Part bred Register when entering the show. **Foals not registered will not be eligible for in hand or sire's ratings points.**
2. All entries to be printed on the entry form enclosed. Entry fees must accompany the entry form otherwise the entry will not be accepted.
3. Entry forms must be completed and signed personally by the exhibitor who will agree to comply with and adhere to the rules of the show.
4. Entry fees - 75% of Entry Fees which includes Stabling, will be refunded only on presentation of a Doctors or Veterinary Certificate within three (3) weeks of the show.
5. In all classes where applicable the name of the pony, date of birth, sire, and dam and stud book number shall be given on the entry form.
6. Those stallions and geldings over three (3) years with temporary registration numbers will **not** be eligible for entry.
7. Ponies/cobs registered and shown as geldings must be gelded.
8. Stallions must be fully registered and not on temporary colt papers when entering the show.
9. All stallions and colts two years and over must wear a bit.
10. All stallions and colts one year and over must be stabled and must not be tied to floats etc.
11. Foals under three weeks of age must not be exhibited.
12. Foals to be led at all times by a separate handler.
13. Purebred Welsh are not to be clipped or plaited. Trimming is permissible, including the ears, throat-latch, lower jaw, jawline and muzzle.
14. When an animal has been entered and catalogued in any class the substitution of another animal will not be permitted unless permission has been approved by the Committee before the show day
15. Entrants not present at the beginning of the class will not be admitted for judging
16. The judge's decision shall be final.
17. The responsibility for accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility of animals completely rests with the exhibitor.
18. The committee at its absolute discretion may refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or decline to admit to the show grounds or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the said grounds.
19. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any animal, person or property.
20. The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the program or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
21. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or divide any class where necessary.
22. The welfare of exhibits is paramount. No lame or sick animal should be brought into a class.
23. All HANDLERS eight (8) years and under MUST AT ALL TIMES have an Adult supervisor accompany them who is not exhibiting in the same class
24. Handlers must be 16 years and over to exhibit a Colt or Stallion.
25. Safety Standard Approved Helmets must be worn at all times by all Riders
26. Classes WILL NOT be delayed if the exhibitor has two classes running concurrently.
27. PROTESTS. All protests must be in writing and be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be refunded only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the protest committee shall be final.

LEAD REIN:

- Judging criteria: 60% suitability, temperament and safeness. 40% conformation and paces.
- Riders must be under 8yrs of age with a minimum of 4yrs. Age is at 1st August 2018.
- Ponies to be led by a leader 14yrs and over with the lead rein attached to the cavesson noseband of a snaffle bridle
- Running or bearing reins or similar tack is not allowed
- Spurs are not allowed. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length which includes a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders
- Ponies will be asked to walk and trot- no cantering under any circumstances

FIRST RIDDEN:

- Judging criteria: 60% suitability, temperament and safeness. 40% conformation and paces
- Riders age limit is under 10yrs. Age is at 1st August 2018
- First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband, snaffle bit and a single rein
- Spurs are not allowed. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length which includes a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders
- All Ponies walk and trot in company, but may be asked to canter in their individual workout.
- The same combination cannot enter in both the lead rein section and First Ridden section or in an open ring however a pony that has entered the Lead Rein can be entered in the First Ridden with a different rider (who is eligible to compete in this section)

RULES:

- Under NZ Occupation Health & Safety it is the responsibility of **EVERYONE** on the grounds to ensure these rules are adhered to. The committee reserves the right to deal with anyone breaching these rules, which may include the removal from the grounds.
- The Committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the program or to postpone or cancel the day as it sees fit. Cancellation will be broadcast on Classic Hits at 8am and posted on Facebook. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any exhibit, exhibitor or spectator, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage. All persons and their property enter the grounds at their own risk. (1)

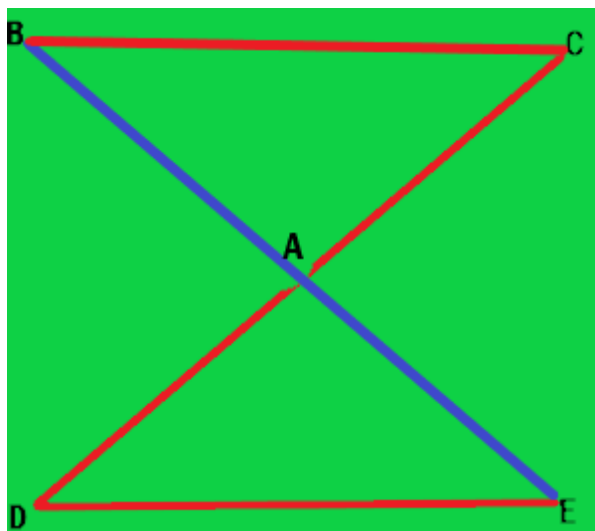
