Transfers

If you are purchasing a registered Welsh Pony or Cob please make sure: You **sight** the registration certificate.

- The person selling the pony should be the registered owner. That is the person named on the front as owner or on the transfer certificate (Box) on the back of the Original Registration Certificate.
- That this transfer has been signed by the Registration Officer – either *D Barker, S I Collins or V Peat*

The Transfer Part.....This is REALLY IMPORTANT

It is very important that the **Seller** signs the Transfer Box on the back of the pony or cob's original Registration Certificate.

PLEASE BE AWARE – you are unable to get a pony transferred into your name without the signature of the previous registered owner of the pony/cob.

Please send Registration Certificate and transfer fee to Zandra Cook 86 Dudley Rd R.D. 6 Inglewood 4386. The transfer fee is \$10 for members and non-members. If you have any doubts please contact the Registration Officer or the Secretary to check if the pony is registered or is eligible for registration and who the registered owner of the pony is.

Buyer Beware

Please note that when you are intending to purchase a Welsh Pony, Cob or Partbred registered with The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand there are things you need to check.

- Make sure you see the WPCS of NZ Registration Certificate.
- If you are buying the pony sight unseen then ask seller to email or fax you a copy of both sides of the Registration Certificate.
- Check the markings described on the certificate corresponds with the actual markings on the pony.
- Make sure the seller is the registered owner. (Either as owner on the front of the Certificate or the last transfer on the back. This transfer must be signed by the Registration Officer)
- Get the seller to complete the transfer certificate at the same time as the sale if at all possible.
- If the papers have been lost check with the Registration Officer that the pony is registered and the seller is the registered owner.
- The pony cannot be transferred into your name without the registered owner's permission (signature).
- If buying a stallion check the WPCSNZ website or with the Registration Officer to ensure he has been DNA typed.
- If buying a stallion or gelding make sure they are stallion or gelding registered and are not on Temporary Colt papers
- You are not able to register foals unless you are the registered owner/lessee of the dam.

Notification of Lease

Notification of Lease; NOTE: This is not a Legal Document or a Legal Contract. Lessees and Owners of Ponies or Cobs must both sign the approved Notification of Lease Form that states the name and registration number of the Pony or Cob. The Notification of Lease Form shall then be forwarded to the Secretary of the Society, with appropriate fee, before registration or entry of progeny can be considered.

Purebred Imports Requirements (excluding geldings) - as from 1 August 2017

All Purebred Imported Ponies & Cobs (excluding geldings) must be parentage DNA proven before leaving their country of origin.

The DNA Certificate must accompany the Export Certificate when sent to the Registrations Officer for Council Approval.

The WPCS of NZ Requirements for Late Registration

- i) Cases of late applications for registration or entry, which are not more than one year, will incur a late fee.
 - ii) Cases of late applications for registration or entry, which are more than one year overdue, will be considered providing the following procedures are followed:
 - iii) DNA Profile has been submitted and compulsory Parental Verification of the DNA profile confirmed as correct.
 - iv) All applicable Fees to be paid by owner.
 - v) All current Registration Requirements must be complied with.

Colt to Stallion Registration Requirements - as from April 2017

The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand requires the dam of a Purebred Temporary Colt to be DNA Parentage (Sire and Dam) Tested when the Temporary colt is upgraded to a Stallion Registration.

Explanation

The Purebred Colts that are Stallion Registered are the WPCS of NZ's future breeding Stallions and that the correctness of their breeding should be verified from both the dam and sire.

Purebred Mare DNA Requirement – as from 1st August 2016

The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand will only register or enter the Purebred Offspring of Purebred Registered Mares, in respect of which all mares are DNA Profiled and if Parent DNA Profiles are available must be Parent Verified

When a Registered Welsh Purebred mare produces a foal which is eligible for Purebred Registration, the Mare must be DNA Profiled (and if Parent DNA Profiles are available must be Parent Verified) before the foal can be registered with the WPCS of NZ.

Foal Registration Requirements

As from the 31st July 2019 the cut off date for registering your Foals is the 31st of July following the foaling season

For one year after the 31st of July following the foaling season the late fee will be \$50.00 up to the 31st of July of the following year

After this period they are **Late Registrations** – Note; Contact the Registrations Officer or the Secretary for the Current Late Registration Requirements.
