

Registration Cut-Off Dates Explained

Foal registrations for the current season should be with the Registrations Officer before 31 May each year.

- Foal registrations should be done before you enter any show. Check the show schedule carefully because most shows now ask for them to be registered when entering the show.

Registration Year Book – if you want your foal entered in this publication you need to have your foal registration to the Registration Officer well before the 31 May.

- Dates for this are published in the newsletters. This year the cut-off date is 16 May – which is earlier than usual to allow some extra time for our new Registration Officer to get the data ready.
- This cut-off date is different because the Yearbook has to be ready for the AGM and it takes time to complete the registrations, compile and print the Yearbook.

Please carefully check your certificates and the Yearbook to ensure your registrations are correct because the information is what will appear in the Studbook being done this year.

Studbooks – once again if you want your foal entered in this publication you need to get your foal registration to the Registration Officer before the cut-off date published in the newsletter. The cut-off date is 31 May 2014 for Volume XII.

Registrations and Payment must be made before the cut off dates – if your registration is held up by NZ Post you will miss out so get them in in plenty of time.

Registrations received after 31 May each season incur a late fee of \$20. You have until the 31 May of the following season to complete these.

Late Registrations

If your pony or cob is not registered before the 31 May of the following season then this is a late registration. Late registrations can be done at any age providing you are able to complete the registration application form (eg provide breeders signature & stallion service certificate) however in addition you must provide

- DNA of foal, pony or cob being registered
- DNA of the registered welsh sire and dam for purebreds
- DNA of registered welsh sire and/or dam for partbreds
- DNA costs \$90 per animal so cost will be from \$90 to \$270.
- The registration cost for a late registration is the current fee (eg \$25 for colt) plus this fee times the age of the pony ($\$25 \times 2 \text{ years}$) which equals \$75.

An example of Registration Fees

<u>Filly foal born 10/12/2013</u>	<u>Registered</u>	<u>Cost</u>
Registered before cut-off date	29 May 2014	\$35
Registered after cut-off date	29 June 2014	$\$35 + \$20 = \$55$
Late Registration	29 June 2015	$\$35 + \$35 \times 2(\text{yrs}) = \105
