PERFORMANCE COMPETITION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition shall be run from 1st May until 30th April of the following year.
2. Applications for entry forms and score cards to: Sandy Mardell, 208 McCully Road, Waitohi, Temuka, south Canterbury 7985 Email: sandymardell@hotmail.com
3. The completed entry forms and score cards to be returned to the above address, no later than 15th May. Each pony to have its own score sheets.
4. All ponies/Cobs (purebred and partbred) entering must be registered with the WPCS of NZ in either the Welsh Stud book or Partbred Register with registration number and full registered name on the entry form
5. All points gained must be from classes under saddle or Harness only.
Classes for turnout and best rider/driver do not count.
Points can be gained from all Welsh shows/A&P shows/Pony club shows/Riding club shows/Ribbon days/Driving club events/scurry driving etc.
6. VERSATILITY – For ponies/Cobs (purebred and Partbred) who excel in two types of events over the course of the year. Ie, Driven and ridden showing or Ridden showing and show jumping, first ridden and dressage etc. Versatility events include all graded and non-graded Dressage, Eventing, ODE, Show Cross, Distance riding, working equitation, Cowboy challenge and any ridden or driven event that has written competition results
7. Pony and rider as a combination can only enter either Lead Rein or First Ridden. Cannot enter both points award in the same season.
8. The competition is open to Stallion, Mares and Geldings 4 years and over.
9. Any pony/Cob/Part bred sold during the competition year may have the previous owners' points transferred to the new owner.

POINTS SCORING

1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point
Champion = 2 points, Reserve Champion = 1 point

THE PERFORMANCE COMPETITION TROPHIES

The **OVERALL CLIFTON TROPHY** and a BRONZE MEDAL: The CLIFTON TROPHY, presented by Lady Diana Isaac and a BRONZE MEDAL donated by the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of New Zealand, is awarded to the over-all winner of the Performance Competition. A Registered Welsh Pony/Cob, Pure or Partbred, gaining the most points during the year. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.

The **VERSATILITY TY GWYN SOLATAIRE MEMORIAL TROPHY**: presented by Dianne Kimpton. This trophy is awarded to the Most Versatile Registered Welsh entry. In the event of that being the Clifton Trophy winner, another Registered Welsh entry is to be selected by the Committee. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.

The **CHAWTON SPRITE SALVER- HARNESS**: presented by Catherine Howell is awarded to a Registered Welsh Pony/Cob with the most points in Harness. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.

The **LORIEN STALLION TROPHY**: presented by Paul and Colleen Rebay, is awarded to the highest scoring Registered Stallion or if there are no Stallions entered, to the Stallion whose Registered Off-spring gain the most points. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.

THE **LIZ DEANS MEMORIAL TROPHY**: presented by Lois Newick, is awarded to the most points in the Leading Rein Section gained by a Registered Welsh. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.

The **DRAGONWYCK TROPHY**: presented by Mary and Terry Naish, to be awarded for the most points in the First Ridden gained by a Registered Welsh. All sections of the Stud Book and Partbred Register are eligible.
