Outline the Remit proposal that you are putting forward.	General Rules – GR: Tidy up length of whip lengths in the Rulebook and Judges Red Manual.
	CURRENT RULE(s)
Rule(s) number(s) and wording of current rule(s) this remit seeks to change.	GR 5. SADDLERY and ACCESSORIES a) Whips in Ridden classes in main rings – Whips shall not exceed 76cm in length; Lead Rein & First Ridden – shall not exceed 68cm including the flap (2cm x 4cm), Whips in Led Classes – shall not exceed 120cm .
	Judges Red Manual - supplement 2016, Turnout & Best Presented Page 26 (at the back of Rule Book after Appendix C, Royal Show Schedule), re Best Presented Led (In Hand) = Canes not to exceed 75cm. In Hand Stallion - Stallion whips are permitted if the exhibit is a stallion or a colt. (No maximum length mentioned).
	PROPOSED NEW RULE(s)
Rule(s) number(s) and wording of new proposed rule(s).	GR 5 SADDLERY and ACCESSORIES a) Whip lengths in - Ridden Classes in main ring - shall not exceed 76cm ; Lead Rein & First Ridden – shall not exceed 76cm including the flap (2cm x 4cm); Whips in Led Classes – shall not exceed 120cm ; Side saddle – length of cane should not exceed 1m . A Dressage whip is also permitted in Side saddle section (as per the NZ Side Saddle Association Rules); In Hand Stallion – whips not exceeding 120cm are permitted if the exhibit is a stallion or a colt.

	RATIONALE
