RATIONALE

Also note any circumstances or events which may have prompted this remit.</i>	Exhibitors should be able to support their local shows and local shows should not miss out on entries due to limited resources. Whilst RAS do not make the rules for HOY, it is worth noting that HOY can still have their current rule in place that the horse/pony must qualify in the section they have nominated and can only enter that section at HOY. There is a real likelihood that a horse or pony may be awarded Champion in 2 sections in a season across the shows, this is by all rights expected in our sport and depends on the competition on the day, the presentation of the exhibit on the day and the opinion of the judge on the day.
