# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All competitors are to be happy and contented and enjoy the day.

- 1. By entering you agree to comply with both the N.I Welsh Pony & Cob Show conditions of entry and the National Equestrian Centre, Taupo, Terms and Conditions.
- 2. All entries to be lodged with "Evo Events".
- 3. Entry and box fees by internet banking. Account: 01-0367-0011777-00 . Must be fully paid prior to show.
- 4. Entries after closing date cannot be accepted except for Progeny Classes.
- 5. All entries to be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of New Zealand Inc in either the Pure Bred Stud Book or Part Bred register. Foals must be registered or eligible for registration.
- 6. In all classes the name of the pony, age, sire, dam and Studbook number shall be provided. Those stallions and Geldings over the age of three (3) years with temporary numbers will not be eligible to enter. Ponies registered as geldings must be gelded. Stallions must be fully registered and not on Temporary colt papers
- 7. The eligibility of the animal to compete rests with the exhibitor or Lessee.
- 8. When an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class, the substitution of another animal will not be permitted on show day. Substitutions can be made but no later than 48 hours prior to show day. Contact the Secretary for conditions.
- 9. All stallions or colts 1 year and over must wear a bit.
- 10. For safety reasons, all stallions and colts over the age of 1 year to be under full control at all times. "Full control" will mean handled by a person 16yrs and over or fully confined within a fully secured enclosure.
- 11. All Stallions must have "S" red badge attached to either side of the bridle and Halter at all times. Red safety bibs and/or armbands are to be worn by stallion handlers.
- 12. No Colt or Stallion to be tied to Truck or float at any time. No paddocks or yards are available for colts or stallions.
- 13. In all classes Ridden and In Hand any Stallion or Colt must be handled / ridden by persons 16yrs and over.
- 14. Entrants not present for judging at the commencement of the class will not be admitted for judging. No classes will be held up.
- 15. Unruly behaviour in the show ring will not be tolerated. Removal from the show ring and/or show will result. Judges decision is final and no refunds will be given.
- 16. Any protest must be lodged in writing at the secretary's office within thirty (30) minutes of the conclusion of the class and accompanied by \$50. (Protests will be heard by 2 or more committee members).
- 17. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, nor loss or damage that may be caused to property, animal, and/or persons.
- 18. The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the program or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit. Refunds will be made for all costs except Evo Events fees and membership subscriptions.
- 19. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes with less than 4 entries in one class.
- 20. Purebred ponies must not be plaited in the Led and Ridden sections
- 21. Regulation hard hats must be worn in all Ridden classes.

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY contd**

- 22. A refund of 75% of entry fee will be given on the presentation of Vets certificate or Doctors certificate.
- 23. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

#### 24. Lead Rein Rules.

Riders 4-8 years as at date of show

Lead rein classes are designed for children on ponies 128 cm and under. These children are those yet unable to ride without assistance from a leader or attendant and will be judged accordingly.

Ponies not to exceed 128cm. Ponies to walk and trot only.

Lead rein to be attached to the caveson nose band of a plain snaffle bridle. Spurs are not allowed.

To be led by a person 16 years and over and to hold the rein with their left hand so the right hand is free to assist the rider if necessary.

Riders taken part in this section are excluded from taking part in other ridden sections of the show.

Riders not have competed off the lead rein in an open ring

#### 25. First Year Ridden Rules

Ponies must be 138 cm and under. Riders must be under 10 yrs as at date of show Ponies will only walk and trot in company but may be asked to canter in individual workout. A first ridden pony must have excellent manners & temperament which is of primary importance.

First ridden ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bit with a cavenson noseband, a snaffle bit and a single rein, no spurs, and competitors may only compete in this ridden section of the show.
